Reporting Dating & Domestic Violence, Sexual Assault & Misconduct, Stalking, or Sex Discrimination

What are my reporting options?

1. Report to the University

- Complete an SIU Campus Incident Report Form at SAFE.SIU.edu
- Call the Office of Equity and Compliance at 618/453-4807 or make an appoint with the office in Woody Hall
- Tell a faculty or staff member. All staff and faculty who work with students are considered “responsible employees” under SIU’s Title IX policy and are mandated to report disclosures of violence, harassment, and discrimination to the university.

2. Report to Law Enforcement

- Call SIU Department of Public Safety at 618/453-3371 or go to the office in the lower level of Trueblood Hall
 - If you report to DPS, the Office of Equity and Compliance will also be informed, but not the other way around.
- Call Carbondale Police Department at 618/457-3200 or go to the station at 501 S. Washington St.
- If you are in immediate danger, call 9-1-1

Not sure if you want to report or what route you want to take? Contact Confidential Advising at 618/453-4441 to discuss your options privately.

Under Title IX and the Clery Act, you do not have to report to the police or the university to access supportive services and accommodations through the Confidential Advisor.
