

# 9 LAWS

## STUDENTS SHOULD KNOW

---



### TRESPASSING

Up to \$2500 fine plus court costs  
Possible ban from premises



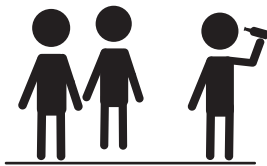
### DISORDERLY CONDUCT

Up to \$2500 fine plus court costs  
Possible jail time  
Community service (if available)



### SERVING MINORS

Up to \$2500 fine plus court costs  
Possible jail time  
Felony charges if death occurs



### PUBLIC POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL

Up to \$2500 fine plus court costs  
Loss of driving privileges (under 21)



### POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA

Civil penalty up to 10 grams  
Possible jail time if >10 grams  
Fines plus court costs  
Ineligible for financial aid



### UNDERAGE CONSUMPTION or POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL

Up to \$2500 fine plus court costs  
Up to 1 year in jail  
Loss of driving privileges



### NOISE COMPLAINT

City Ordinance Violation  
Up to \$750 fine plus court costs



### SOCIAL HOST

Up to \$2500 fine plus court costs  
Felony charges if death or great bodily injury occurs



### FAKE ID

Up to \$2500 fine  
Felony charges in some circumstances  
Loss of driving privileges

In addition to city and state penalties, these are also violations of the Student Conduct Code which are handled separately from any legal matters.
