

BE HEARD: IT'S EVERYONE'S ISSUE

A SEXUAL MISCONDUCT SURVEY

Students are encouraged to Be Heard by participating in an anonymous, online Sexual Misconduct Campus Climate Survey, which will be open until May 10th. The survey is being conducted by Shelly Ridgeway, Director of Wellness and Health Promotion Services at SIUC. The 15-20 minute survey examines students' experiences with sexual violence and perceptions of campus safety. Responses will help improve campus programming and services.

You must be 18 years or older to complete the survey. Your participation is voluntary; participation in this survey will have no effect on your grades, class standing, services, or care. There is no penalty if you chose not to participate or to withdraw prior to completion. Survey questions may be skipped if you chose not to answer. You may exit out of the survey at any time, and your responses will not be recorded. All recorded responses will remain anonymous.

Some of the survey questions are personal and you might experience emotional discomfort while answering them. There is a very low risk to participation, but there is always a risk of breach of confidentiality. Deidentified data may be shared with other researchers in the future, and federal or state laws may require us to show information to university or government officials (or sponsors) who are responsible for monitoring the safety of this study. The benefits of participation are improved services for students.
